SECRETARIES REPORT GONE OVER. BILL MOVED TO ACCEPT THE REPORT. SECOND BY DALLY. MOTION CARRIED.

TREASURER'S REPORT. MARV REPORTED THE BALANCE IN OUR CHECKING ACCOUNT ON 03/29/2019 WAS \$4235.35 AND OUR SAVINGS ACCOUNT WAS \$6089.33. ANTHONY MOVED TO ACCEPT THE REPORT. SECOND BY DAN. MOTION CARRIED.

BRAD TALKED TO THE OSSEO POLICE CHIEF ABOUT GETTING THE SPEED LIMITS INCREASED ON THE APPROVED ATV ROUTES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS. THEY WOULD BE INCREASED FROM 10 MPH TO 25 MPH TO CORRESPOND WITH MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC. THIS HAS BEEN APPROVED AND WILL BE SIGNED AT A MEETING LATER THIS WEEK. IT WILL BECOME EFFECTIVE AS SOON AS IT IS PUBLISHED IN THE PAPER. THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE DNR WILL BE CRACKING DOWN ON KIDS WHO VIOLATE ATV LAWS. 1ST OFFENCE WILL BE A TICKET, NO EXCEPTIONS. THEY CAN HAVE THE TICKET BE FORGIVEN IF THEY ATTEND A MEETING OF OUR CLUB AND JOIN IT. THEY WOULD THEN

BE GIVEN A 20 OR SO QUESTION TEST ABOUT LAWS AND RULES FOR ATV RIDERS WHICH WOULD BE GIVEN BY OUR CLUB THAT THEY WOULD NEED TO PASS. HWY 10 AND HWY 53 WOULD NOT BE OPENED UP FOR RIDING ON. ONLY APPROVED CITY STREETS. THE ONLY TIME IT IS LEGAL TO RIDE ON OTHER CITY STREETS IS WHEN YOU RIDE FROM YOUR RESIDENCE TO AN APPROVED DESIGNATED ROUTE.

WE RECEIVED 15 CARDS BACK FROM OUR BUSINESS SPONSORS AFTER LAST YEARS POKER RUN IN AUGUST. THESE WERE FOR THEIR INPUT ON IF THEY HAD ANY SUGGESTIONS TO IMPROVE IT ON THE BUSINESS SIDE. THE MAIN COMPLAINT WAS ABOUT ONE PERSON COMING IN WITH UP TO 15 SHEETS TO BE STAMPED AND THE PERSON NOT PURCHASING ANYTHING FROM THE BUSINESS. WE MAY NEED TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF SHEETS EACH PERSON CAN BRING IN TO BE STAMPED. REALLY STRESS PURCHASING SOMETHING AT THE BUSINESS EVEN IF IT IS A SODA OR CHIPS. EVERY LITTLE BIT HELPS THE BUSINESS.

MARV, BRAD AND MARY ATTENDED THE ANNUAL WATVA MEETING IN STEVENS POINT LAST WEEKEND. WATVA HAS BEEN AROUND FOR ABOUT 10 YEARS. THERE ARE LOTS OF CLUBS AROUND THE STATE BUT THEY HAVE NOT JOINED WATVA. WE BELONG AS A CLUB. THE COST IS ONLY \$80.00 PER YEAR. WE GET A LOT OF SUPPORT AND INFORMATION FROM WATVA. THERE WERE A LOT OF DIFFERENT SESSIONS TO ATTEND. SOME HELPFUL AND SOME NOT SO MUCH.

MARY ADVISED ONE SESSION SUGGESTED DOING SOMETHING FOR KIDS. GET THEM INVOLVED. MORE PARENTS WOULD MAYBE JOIN A CLUB. WE COULD HOLD AN EVENT MAUYBE AT THE ROD & GUN CLUB. HAVE A CLASS ON RULES, BRING IN THE DNR, EMS, POLICE DEPT AND FIRE DEPT. TO TALK. HAVE FOOD AND DRINKS FOR PURCHASE.

ANNA MOVED TO SET UP A COMMITTEE TO LOOK INTO THIS. POSSIBLY HAVE IT THIS SUMMER. SECOND BY MARY. MOTION CARRIED.

THERE WERE 323747 ATV'S AND 78724 UTV'S REGISTERED IN WISCONSIN LAST YEAR. THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE ATV'S AND UTV'S THAT ARE USED PRIVATELY THAT DON'T HAVE TO BE REGISTERED.

THERE HAS BEEN DISCUSSION ON EVERYONE NEEDING TO PURCHASE A TRAIL PASS EVERY YEAR LIKE WITH SNOWMOBILES. THERE IS NO INTEREST IN DOING THIS AT THIS TIME. NOT EVEN HALF THE CLUBS IN THE STATE BELONG TO WATVA UNLIKE SNOWMOBILE CLUBS WHERE MOST OF THEM BELONG TO THEIR STATE ORGANIZATION. THE ATV ASSOCIATION ONLY RECEIVED .001% OF THE GAS TAX. THIS IS SET ON THE PURCHASE OF EACH 25 GALLONS OF GAS.

MARY TALKED TO PEOPLE OVER THE WINTER ABOUT GETTING ATV MAPS PRINTED FOR OUR AREA. WE COULD SELL ADVERTISING SPOTS ON THE MAP TO BUSINESSES FOR POSSIBLY \$75.00 EACH. SHE IS GETTING THE COST FOR 500-1000 MAPS.

THE POLARIS RIDE COMMAND MAP CAN BE DOWNLOADED ONTO YOUR SMART PHONE. USE IT WHEN YOU ARE OUT RIDING. SHOWS ATV ROUTES AND TRAILS.

MONTHLY RIDES WILL BE SET UP. THINKING ABOUT RIDING EITHER THE WEEKEND BEFORE OR AFTER OUR MONTHLY MEETING.

MARY HAS BEEN WORKING ON GETTING CLUB HATS.

MAKE A WISH IS HOLDING A RIDE IN ANTIGO ON OCTOBER 12. THEY ARE LOOKING FOR RIDERS AND DONATIONS FOR THE RAFFLES. MAYBE WE SHOULD EITHER RIDE OR DO A DONATION.

WILL DISCUSS PARADES AT THE NEXT MEETING.

DISCUSSION ON ADOPTING A SECTION OF THE BUFFALO RIVER TRAIL. ELEVA-STRUM CLUB AND THE MONDOVI CLUB HAVE ADOPTED PART OF THE TRAIL IN THEIR AREAS. THIS WOULD MEAN WE WOULD TAKE CARE OF SIGNING MAINLY AND BRUSHING WHEN NEEDED. SHOULD WE DO THIS. BRYAN MOVED TO DO THIS. SECOND BY BILL. CARRIED.
